



Public notice is hereby given that the Township of North Versailles will be conducting an examination for full-time police officers for the North Versailles Township Police Department.

The North Versailles Township Police Department is offering experience-based salary if the applicant meets the criteria below:

**Applicants, pending review and approval by the Township Board of Commissioners, with uninterrupted and current full-time employment as a police officer in Pennsylvania will be compensated with salary in accordance with the years of service schedules in the current police collective bargaining agreement reflective of their years of service at their current police employer. If prior employment years of service is approved by the Board of Commissioners, the applicant will adhere to all other contractual requirements for a newly hired officer including but not limited to a probationary period, vacation, rank in seniority rotation, shift selections, overtime call-outs and any other benefits related to seniority and/or hire date.**

Those interested in applying for this position must be a US citizen, be currently certified in PA Act 120 or have passed the final exam and be eligible for certification, be a PA licensed vehicle operator and possess at least a high school diploma.

North Versailles Township offers excellent healthcare to its police officers along with up to 5 weeks of vacation, 4 personal days per year, 12 sick days per year (up to 100 banked) and up to 320 hours of compensatory time. Police Officers must live within 12.5 air miles of the Township. Police Officers work a 5 day a week, 8-hour fixed schedule, with ample shift and elective overtime opportunities.

Totaling around 9 square miles in size with approximately 10,000 residents, North Versailles is located in the eastern portion of Allegheny County sharing borders with North Huntingdon, Monroeville, McKeesport, White Oak, East McKeesport, East Pittsburgh, Wilmerding and Turtle Creek.
